Evanston's Howard Levy is the supreme virtuoso of the harmonica, and he makes his ESO debut playing his own Concerto for Diatonic Harmonica, as well as improvising special interludes within Gershwin's classic *Porgy and Bess* orchestral suite. Award winning composer Christopher Theofanidis was commissioned by a consortium of orchestras, including the ESO, to create a new 17 minute work for
